### DRESS CODE

Our staff are trained in all aspects of onboard safety and comply fully with national safety regulations.

### SECURITY

A discreet security presence is an essential part of our operation, and it may be necessary for passengers to make themselves and their luggage available for inspection. All cabins have a safe with a code. Your cabin should be locked upon leaving - please ask your steward for a key. Andean Explorer is not responsible for the loss of valuable items left unattended. All cabins have a safe, the guests can use it with no problems. Every guest will get a key of the cabin.
